

I have just finished up another year of sharing my love of reading with the local school children. The schools allow me to visit the children in Head Start, and Pre-K through 4th grade. I go to Peakview, Gardner Valley School, South Central Colorado Head Start, and Southern Colorado Council of Governments Early Learning Center. I read books and do action songs with the Pre-K and kindergarten age children once a week. I go to the older children's classrooms once a month and read a book and then do a craft activity to go with it. I really love this part of my job. When I see the children out in the community and they come running up to give me a hug, I feel like a celebrity.

We are starting a new program at the library this month. It is called 1000 Books Before Kindergarten. Many children struggle with reading. It has been found that simply reading to children from birth can help them be better readers. You can do this by taking the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten challenge, read a book, any book to your child, with the goal of reading 1,000 before kindergarten. We have more information at the library. You can track their books on paper forms, which we have or you can use an app on your phone. For every hundred books that your child reads, they will be recognized on a display at the library and be given a prize.

We will be having a Summer Learning Program during the month of July. It will start with a party at 10:30 am Friday, July 1. We will be having 3 special performers this year as well as fun activities every Friday at 10:30 am. Check our Facebook page for updates. The theme
